FOOD FROM THE HEART 2017

1. In the school's bid to nurture caring students sincere in serving fellow Singaporeans, Kong Hwaians will take the lead in a community project, in collaboration with charitable organisation, *Food from the Heart*. The project aims to raise community awareness of less privileged children, and aid them through donations of food items.
2. As such, we would like to appeal for your generous contribution of **non-perishable food items**. Donated food items will be collected, sorted and distributed by P4 Kong Hwaians as part of their Values in Action Project. Through this, they will become more aware of the means through which they can contribute to improving the lives of the less privileged.
3. In addition, through working in groups for the project, our P4 Kong Hwaians will be provided with opportunities to demonstrate leadership, interpersonal, and self-management skills. The combination of values, knowledge and skills will shape them to become a confident person, self-directed learner, concerned citizen and active contributor.
4. Details of the food items collection are as follows:

Period of Collection: 10 July (Monday) - 13 July (Friday)

List of requested non-perishable food:

- Rice
- Cooking Oil
- Condensed Milk
- Canned Food (Sardine, Baked Beans, Button Mushroom, Curry Chicken, etc.)
- Biscuits
- Rice Vermicelli
- Instant Noodles
- Drinks Sachets (Milo, Coffee, Tea, etc.)
- Sugar

Please note that all donated food items have to be good for at least 3 months before the expiry date.

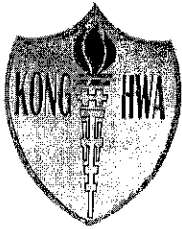

National Education Events

1. Racial Harmony Day – 21 July 2017 (Friday)

We will be commemorating Racial Harmony Day on **21 July 2017**. This year, the theme for Racial Harmony Day is ***The Singapore Way***. As we make the journey from tolerating differences to embracing diversity, our Singapore identity continues to develop. It is important that Racial Harmony is part of this identity and way of life, and that our students, on whose shoulders our future lie, make Racial Harmony a key aspect of their hopes and dreams for what Singapore is and could be.


