4. Secondary School of Choice

To motivate your child to learn diligently, you may visit the MOE E-careers portal at <https://ecareers.sg/> to learn more about your child's choice school under '*Find Your Favourite School*'. It provides information like PSLE T-score ranges for the past 3 years, programmes, CCAs, etc. From the portal, your child can also find out about the different pathways in education. For example, the difference between Integrated Programme (IP), Specialised Independent Schools, mainstream secondary schools, etc.

Alternatively, you and your child may browse the various secondary schools' websites for more details on their programmes and CCAs.

5. Distractions from Digital Devices and Social Media

Spending too much time on digital devices can impact on your child's learning. In school, we do not encourage pupils to bring mobile phones. However, we recognize the need for communication between parent and child. Thus, pupils can only use their mobile phones in school at Gate 3 and Gate 6 and in the school canteen after school for the purpose of communication with parents.

At home, we hope that you can help to set rules for usage of digital devices. Your child is advised to turn off digital devices during homework and revision hours. In addition, mobile phones should be kept away at night. It is important that your child gets sufficient rest to maintain a good level of focus and attention in class the next day.

Furthermore, social media may also pose problems in social management. Casual remarks by friends could be taken seriously and negatively. In these crucial few months, we urge you to monitor your child's well-being closely and advise your child to think positively.

6. Code of Conduct for Examination



At times, a moment of child's play or folly may cause undesirable anguish for you and the school during investigation and pending conclusion from investigation. Therefore, it is mandatory to abide by the code of conduct for examination.

Absence During School-based Weighted Assessments

- Any pupil who is absent from school-based weighted assessments due to illness must produce a valid medical certificate (MC).
- If a pupil is absent due to other reasons, a letter of excuse with supporting document(s) is required to substantiate his/her absence. This is subjected to school's decision.
- The MC or letter of excuse with supporting document(s) must be submitted to the school on the day the absentee returns to school.
- Any pupil with flu-like symptoms and/or fever of 37.6°C and above is advised to seek medical care and should not take the assessment. It is not to the pupil's advantage. Pupils with MC are advised to stay at home.

Conduct of Make-up Assessments
