Mathematics

Math Olympiad

P5 pupils who have been undergoing Math Olympiad Training in 2016 will be invited to continue with the training this year. The training will start on 18 January in preparation for those who would like to participate in Hwa Chong Maths Olympiad Competition and Raffles Institution World Math Contest.

English

Learning Journey to Jurong Bird Park

The P2 pupils will be going on a learning journey to the Jurong Bird Park in Term 1. This trip enables them to work with their classmates as they observe some birds and learn more about them.

Debate Course

The debate course is a continuation from the P5 debate course for 30 Primary 6 pupils. It is a 2-hour 6 session course that will run through from February to April. Pupils will be able to further hone their debating skills with this course. They will be taught how to think on their feet and organise their thoughts before they speak. Selected pupils will represent the school to participate in the Wits and Words 2017 debate competition organised by the Gifted Branch.

Alumni NY Celebration at Tai Pei Old People's Home

This January 15 2017, a group of our P5 prefects will be paying a visit to the Tai Pei Elders' Home, as is tradition, to bring some festive Lunar New Year cheer to the seniors. They will be accompanied by members of our Alumni, school leaders, and teachers.

Green Movement @ KHS

In continuing our efforts in recycling, we will be collecting old newspapers and other recyclables on the last Friday of every month. Weight of recyclables collected will be tallied and contributes to the scores of each class for the Green Class Award. As the last Friday in January coincides with our CNY celebrations, collection of the recyclables will be on 20 Jan 2017. We look forward to the generous contributions from Kong Hwaians.

KHS Road Safety Education Programme

The school aims to bring about safety awareness and inculcate safe habits in our pupils when using the road so as to ensure their own safety as well as the safety of others around them. In Term 1, a talk on Road Safety will be conducted during our assembly and our P4 pupils will be visiting the Road Safety Park to learn more about good road safety behaviour.

P1 Buddy Programme 2017

The P1 Buddy Programme aims to ease the P1 pupils into the routines of the new school life, new environment and unfamiliar social setting. Through this programme, the school hopes to provide our P5 and P6 pupils with the opportunity to play their role as buddies to the P1 pupils and contribute within the school. During the programme, our P5 and P6 pupils buddy up with P1 pupils during the first 2 weeks of school during recess, accompanying and guiding the younger ones.

Conversational Malay Language for P3 and 4

Commenced in March 2007, MOE launched the Conversational Chinese-Malay (CCM) programme with the objective of equipping both primary and secondary pupils with the spoken language of another ethnic group. Participating pupils in this programme are taught to engage in simple daily conversations such as greetings, using the mother-tongue of another racial group. Learning the Malay language opens the door for pupils to acquire even greater knowledge of another ethnic group's culture, thereby strengthening multi-racial ties and promoting harmony. P3 and 4 pupils can seize the opportunity to enrol in the Basic or Beginner module. More details will be furnished later.

Science

Science Centre Workshops for P3 & P4 Students

To enhance students' experience in learning Science, the Science Department will be organising excursions to the Science Centre in Term 1 for our P3 and P4 students to take part in workshops. Our P3 students will be attending the 'Fun with Animals' workshop to complement their learning in the theme of 'Diversity'. Each class will attend one workshop scheduled between 10 Jan and 2 May. Our P4 students will attend the 'Moving Machines' workshop - a toy-making, tinkering programme to enhance their innovative and creative thinking. Each class will attend a workshop scheduled on 7, 9 or 14 February.
