Your child would have received a copy of a little blue journal titled "Where Will You Go?" This is an activity journal that was specially designed to help your child on his or her Education and Career Guidance (ECG) journey.

## **ECG Activity Journal**

- 2. The journal contains various activities and questions meant to help your child at various stages of their lives, to know the main ECG concerns and issues they should be familiar with.
- 3. The activities and questions will get them to start thinking and be curious about their interests, abilities and passion. The Journal also encourages them to log-on to the new MySkillsFuture Student Portal (see appended instructions to do so) to continue their journey and discover more. Students will be introduced this year to the portal in October (P6) and November (P5). In the interim, here is how you can use the journal at home to complement school efforts in ECG.

## How You Can Be Involved


- 4. We have created this journal such that you can also go through the journal together with your child, find relevance for your own life stage and spark a conversation with your family on the choices you have made at different parts of your life.
- 5. Here's how we imagine your child and you could use it:
- Your child would likely first flip to the section of the Activity Journal that relates to their life-stage and complete the activities there.
- The last activity gets your child to start thinking about their next stage of life and piques their interest to explore more.
- Your child can then flip back or forward to see what the activities and messages are under the "Secondary" or "Post-Secondary" sections and even beyond.
- You can also refer to the section most relevant to you and complete the activities together with your child, even flip back to your child's section and then talk about your different responses or decisions.
- We imagine that this then would help you and your child to talk and think about your ECG journeys together.
- 6. We hope that you will have fun going through the Activity Journal with your child and that you will find the questions and activities useful to start thinking about ECG.



- 8. If you have any questions, feel free to approach your child's teacher. Thank you!


